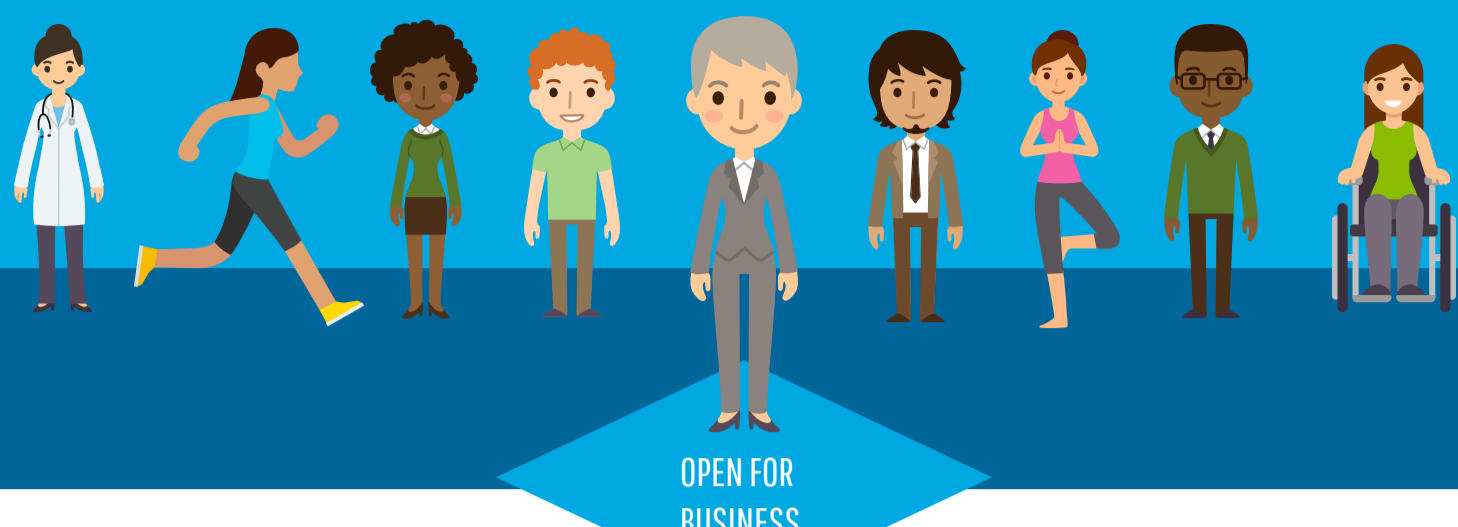


# CORA is COMMITTED

here are a few steps we have taken



### 1 Prevention

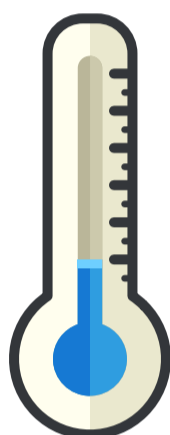
**Prevention** is the key to stopping the spread of COVID-19: wearing a mask, washing hands frequently, social distancing, regular cleaning and disinfecting and staying home when sick.



We have asked all patient family members or others attending the therapy session to not be present in the clinic or waiting room during the visit. This small ask will help prevent the spread.

### 2 Continuous monitoring

**Employees are required to take their temperature daily.** Any provider with a temperature over 99.5 is required to stay at home, and be fever free for 72 hours. Additionally we are following all recommendations issued.



### 3 Clinic Cleaning and Disinfecting

**All clinics are following CDC recommendations.** This includes: disinfection of tables, doorknobs, light switches, countertops, handles, desks, phones, keyboards, toilets, faucets, and sinks using solutions with at least 60% alcohol. Laundry is being done on the warmest setting.



### 4 Patient Screening

**A patient questionnaire is provided to every patient on each visit.** This will minimize risk to patients and employees.



Answering "YES" requires the patient to immediately leave the facility and self-quarantine.

### 5 Telehealth and Therapy in the Home

**Do you have symptoms? Or has it been recommended to stay at home?** Your provider is able to do a live video-conference while you stay at home. They will be able to provide quality treatment and education. If telehealth is not a solution talk to a provider about Therapy in the Home.



### 6 Keeping Up to Date
